Report on IPR Seminar organised by IQAC on 22 July,2022 at 11.a.m. at Thiruvalluvar Hall

The Intellectual Property Rights Seminar on "Identifying Intellectual Components at the Early Stage of Innovation" was organized by IQAC Coordinator on 22July,2022. The program began with the singing of Tamil Thai Vazhthu. The program began ceremoniously by the lighting of the sacred lamp by the members on the dais. IQAC Coordinator Dr.V.Sadhasivam welcomed the members and introduced the Resource Person Mr.B.Ahilan, Deputy Controller, Indian Patent Office, Chennai. Principal- in- charge Dr.Nahoor Selvam honoured the guest with a shawl and memento. After which he delivered the Presidential Address.


The Organizing Secretary Dr.P.Mythily, presented the Seminar Concept. She deliberated how IPR is pertinent in the digital era, the creator's exclusive right over the use of his/her creation. Inorder to ensure that all inventions remain protected under law, IP owners should be aware of the components of IPR. This will help them to shield their creations from being duplicated or copied by others As India is a fast growing economy, innovation is gaining prominence among Indian Industries and the government. This innovation needs protection and for this IPR is necessary.

Mr.Ahilan in his presentation explained IPR, the various components of it, Indians lacking knowledge of IPR, Government's awakening about the necessity of patenting the intellectual properties, and Government's vision of "IP and Youth inventing for Better Future" and "Produce and Prosper". Registering their invention is less in India because of lack of awareness. He made an appeal to the students to create and spread the message of patenting our intellectual properties. If the products are good the government provides an opportunity to export.

Mr.Ahilan spoke about the difference between parents and copyright. He pointed out many products and how they are patented. (Designs, English and Math formula are included under copyright). Online filing is available and the Institutions are expected to have patent rights to be ranked by NIRF and NAAC. The patent rights will be valid for a certain period and then it lapses. Only if the invention is useful the product can be patented. The speaker concluded his speech by wishing the students a bright future.




