2023-24 Annual report

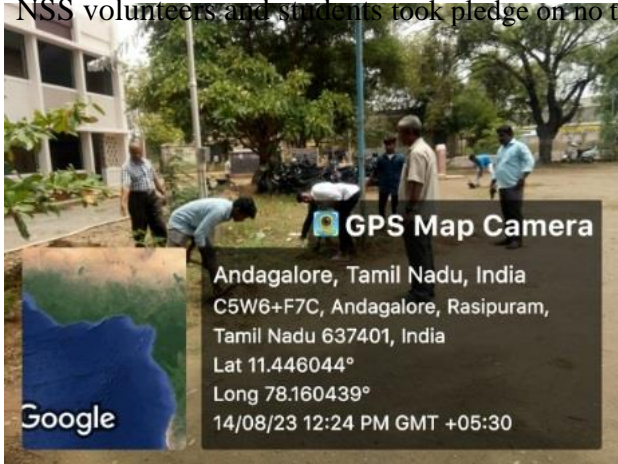

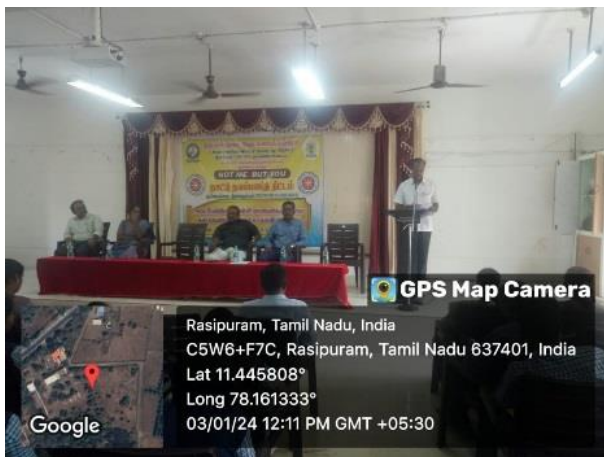
First day of the forenoon session of guidance programme was started at 9 o'clock in the college auditorium. Around 210 students were participated on 03-01-2024. Dr. S.
